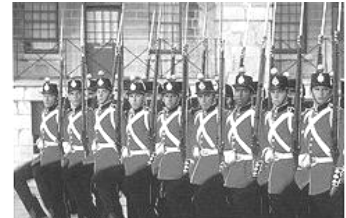
October 10, 2008 (Friday)
